



WELCOME TO THE MEDICAL TRANSIENT DETACHMENT AT LANDSTUHL REGIONAL MEDICAL CENTER!

Greeting and Welcome to Landstuhl Regional Medical Center (LRMC). We hope that this guide is an informative resource and assists you with any questions you may have. This document covers what to expect during your stay at our Medical Transient Detachment (MTD) and amenities available at LRMC. Although this document may not answer all of your questions, we hope that it will answer many of them.

THE MTD MISSION

Our mission is to provide company level mission command, administrative and logistical support, and quality of life needs to the evacuated wounded, ill and injured service members of LRMC and medically TDY outpatients and non-medical attendants.

Evacuated Service Members

All deployed Service Members will first inprocess at the Deployed Warrior Medical Management Center (DWMMC) Missions desk located at BLDG 3766, RM 15B 119. Service members will not receive a room at the MTD until they have inprocessed through DWMMC. All deployed Service Members will receive Housing and Meals at no cost to the Service Member or their Unit.

Medical TDY

Upon arrival to the MTD you will be inprocessed and receive a room. Linens are available upon inprocessing. Please arrive with your DD1610 or with your DTS prepared (see your unit representative). Housing is no cost to the Service Member or their unit, however your meals are not, the patient and escort will need to have per diem authorized. LRMC has a dining facility and food court available to patients and escorts.

Accountability

IAW MTD Policy Letter 13. All Service Members are required to report for accountability from 0800-0830 and again from 1900-2000 daily. Senior Non-Commissioned Officers (E-7 and higher), Commissioned Officers (O-3 and higher), and all Warrant Officers are exempt from evening accountability. Following evening accountability Service Members are restricted to LRMC. All Service members regardless of Rank or Position are restricted to MTD premises from 2200-0500, unless granted pass by Unit CoC, Provider, NCM, and MTD CoC as the final approval authority.

Amenities within the Landstuhl Regional Medical Center

MTD

- Chaplain and USO day trips available if medically cleared and no conflicting appointments
- Rooms have a dorm sized refrigerator, microwave, and DSN
- Linens will be provided upon arrival

- Laundry rooms provided in the building
- Free Wi-Fi access
- Guests are not authorized in assigned MTD rooms
- Base gym is located nearby and available for use
